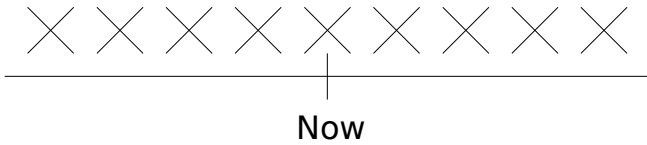


## Simple Present

Steven **is** a good teacher.

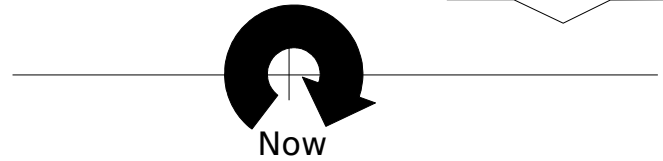
I **study** at Berlitz. I **have** class every Monday with Steven.

In progress  
now



I **am looking** at Steven's summary of important verb tenses. I think it's excellent.

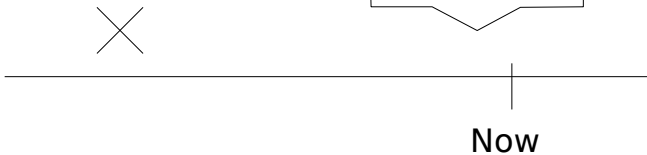
I **am sitting** down.

## Simple Past

Yesterday  
Last week  
When I was young  
On my birthday

Finished  
Has a  
context



- What time **did** Steven **go** for a swim in the lake?  
-He **went** for a swim at half past five in the morning.

We **studied** verb tenses in class on the 19<sup>th</sup> of May..

## Past Continuous

At 6 o' clock  
This time yesterday  
When I walked into the bar  
The phone rang while...

In progress at  
a particular  
time



- What **was** Steven **doing** at 6 o' clock in the morning?  
-He **was swimming** in the lake.

I **was sleeping** when the phone rang.

At half past seven on Monday, we **were talking** about immigration and the equality of women in class.

Think about these questions;

What do you do? What are you doing?

What were you doing at this time yesterday?

What did you do yesterday?

Where did you go on holiday last year?
